
This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written if we have additional comments or concerns.

I have reviewed your draft owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577. However, in your owner letter you state "Beaver Marquis Sapphire." Is this the correct model name?

Also a sentence needs to be added concerning leased vehicles, i.e., **Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.**

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during February 2003. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by April 30, 2003.
