**SUBJECT: 126 Skyline 2001-2002 Nomad, Aljo, and Layton brand "Sportwagon" travel trailers and fifth wheel trailers manufactured from January 3 through October 12, 2001. The screws used to attach the lift bed support bracket to the wood bed frame are too short causing the bed to separate from the support bracket.**
