Subject: Safety Recall 11E-057
Models: All Trailers with electric/hydraulic brakes manufactured between October 1, 2011 and January 31, 2012
Date: April 17, 2012

PJ Trailers has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2012 model year trailers equipped with electric/hydraulic brakes.

PJ Trailers has identified that certain brake actuators manufactured by Dexter Axles, may not have been properly heat treated during the manufacturing process. This condition can cause premature wear of some critical components in these pumps which can render the units inoperable. This could result in loss of braking effort by the trailer possibly resulting in a vehicle crash.

In order to correct this issue, each trailer must be first inspected to verify that the serial number on the actuator matches the range that is eligible for replacement.

K71-650-00 (E/H 1000 psi) – Serial #DTS11903 to DTS12759
K71-651-00 (E/H 1600 psi) – Serial #DTS13805 to DTS14751

It is very important that each trailer be inspected and repaired, if necessary, in a timely manner. If you have any questions about the process, please call PJ Trailers Customer Service at (866) 752-8781.

Important: Some of the involved vehicles may still be in dealer inventory. Federal law requires you to complete the recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery.

Completion Reporting and Reimbursement

It is very important that each trailer that is a part of this recall be inspected and then the findings reported to PJ Trailers Mfg. Co. This information is necessary to clear each trailer of the recall in our records.

If a unit is found to be included in the serial range above, then you must contact us so that we can arrange to have a replacement unit sent to you. Customers have also been instructed to call PJ Trailers to verify if their pump is a part of the recall. This will save you some time in handling this issue. Once we receive the proper information, we will submit it to Dexter Axles, who will send a replacement pump and a return label for the defective pump. They will also cover the labor to swap out the pumps. An invoice will be needed to get credit for this.
