You should begin preparations for this campaign now. A manufacturer that has determined that a safety defect exists in a motor vehicle is required by Section 151 of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act to notify potential distributors, dealers/retailers, and purchasers of the defective equipment and to provide a free remedy.

We require a proposed schedule or agenda for the implementation of this recall. The schedule should address the dates on which notification to distributors, dealers, and purchasers will be issued, when a press release will be issued, and when parts necessary for the recall will be available. It is otherwise assumed that this recall shall begin nationally, and uniformly, within 30 calendar days.
