Greetings Kelly,

I really appreciate the recent contact and assistance in getting this issue resolved, as far as our end is concerned. In February of this year we were notified through our vender, Redneck Trailer Supply, of the possibility of a defective brake actuator supplied to them from Carlisle Brake and Friction.

After a thorough check of all our records of the item in question we determined we had ordered five (5) of the actuators which possibly could be effected by the recall. Our records indicated we had four (4) still in warehouse and one (1) on a unit that was retail sold.

I personally inspected each of the units in stock and determined each one was not within the serial/model numbers determined to be defective. I also communicated to the retail customer the information I received and explained how we could determine if the unit on his trailer was or was not considered defective. The customer took pictures of the serial / model numbers as requested and I examined these against those supplied by Carlisle B & F. This unit was also not within those determined to be defective.

To put it simply, we are truly thankful to declare all the units which were purchased by Universal Trailer Corporation (Exiss/Sooner - Horse/Livestock Division) 900 E. Trail Blvd. – El Reno, OK – 73036, are determined to be okay and not within the range of those units which were considered or suspected to be defective.
