**IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL**

Subject: Safety Recall #PPD1202 – TRP Aluminum Wheel Rim Marking  
NHTSA Campaign Number: 12E-053

Dear Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

PACCAR Parts has decided that certain TRP Aluminum wheels which were sold for resale in the aftermarket with one of the following part numbers: AW2258B, AW2258M, AW2458B or AW2458M, fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 120. "Tire Selection and Rims for Motor Vehicles Other Than Passenger Cars." The rim markings on these wheels were etched to a depth less than the minimum requirements of the standard. Without proper rim markings, owners may not be able to identify affected wheels in the event of a wheel recall. Defective or noncompliant wheels that are not remedied are at an increased risk of performance failure, and thereby increase the risk of a crash or other safety hazard to motorists. Our records reflect that you may have purchased one or more of the affected wheels.

<b><i>What PACCAR Parts will do ...</i></b>	Offer a replacement TRP aluminum wheel in exchange for the non-compliant wheel
<b><i>What you must do ...</i></b>	Contact your dealer

PACCAR Parts has initiated a recall to replace the affected TRP Aluminum wheels. Please contact your Kenworth or Peterbilt dealer to exchange the non-compliant wheel for a compliant wheel. The wheel will be exchanged at no charge to you.
