

## *Safety Recall Notice*

Dear Dealer:

This **Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the United States National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Eldorado has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain *Amerivan* wheelchair accessible vans manufactured between February 17, 2011 and June 25, 2013 that were built using the Toyota Sienna Minivan.

All of the vans subject to this recall campaign contain a safety defect that allows the left rear shock absorber to contact the fuel filler neck during extreme compression of the shock absorber. This potentially could damage the fuel filler neck allowing gasoline or gasoline vapors to escape which could result in a fire or explosion causing personal injury or death.

The required action is to relocate the bottom of the shock absorber to the OEM specified location and add a spacer to the top shock mount location.
