RE: Safety Recall: 2013 Accord Fuel Tank Leak Parts Update

On July 5, 2013, American Honda notified NHTSA of a **Stop Sale** order and **Safety Recall** for some 2013 Accord units. Any new or used units in dealer stock must be repaired per S/B 13-054: *Safety Recall: Fuel Tank Leaking at Fuel Tank Unit* prior to sale. **Refer to eResponsibility and VIN Inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

Please note that there are a very small number of units affected by this recall – nationally, fewer than 1,600 4-door models, and under 70 2-door models. Due to the small number of affected vehicles in the market, it is very unlikely that your dealership will require multiple fuel tank kits. Furthermore, additional allocations will be made to dealerships to continue addressing stop sale units. Until customer notification begins in early August, American Honda does not anticipate high customer demand for these tank kits, and we ask that dealers do not place orders for additional tanks unless an affected unit is identified.
