Subject: FCCC MTG45/55 Gasoline Fuel Tanks**

Daimler Trucks North America has begun notifying its dealers and customers of a safety related defect that exists in certain chassis manufactured by Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation and delivered to your company. A remedy without charge is now available, and owners may take their vehicle to a Daimler Trucks North America-authorized service facility to have the recall performed. The Recall Bulletin, which includes a representative copy of the owner notification and dealer work instructions, and a list of potentially affected vehicles delivered to you are attached for your information.

Your company may have an obligation to notify its dealers, distributors, and customers of this recall under Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 577.13 and/or Motor Vehicle Safety Act Section 10(1).

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: FCCC MTG45/55 Gasoline Fuel Tanks

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. This notice applies to your vehicle(s).

Daimler Trucks North America LLC, on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiary, Freightliner Custom Chassis Corporation, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on specific Freightliner Custom Chassis MTG45/55 gasoline engine walk-in van chassis manufactured February 15, 2010, through August 6, 2013.

Certain gasoline fuel tanks may experience cracks in the tank skin or welds due to fatigue, leading to a possible leak of gasoline or fumes. A fuel leak, when in the presence of an ignition source, could increase the risk of a fire.

Parts are now available and the fuel tanks will be replaced. **IMPORTANT: All vehicles require a fuel tank replacement, even those that had an interim replacement.**

Please contact an authorized Daimler Trucks North America dealer to arrange to have the recall performed and to ensure that parts are available at the dealership. To locate an authorized dealer, search online at www.Daimler-TrucksNorthAmerica.com. The Recall will take approximately three hours and will be performed at no charge to you.

You may be liable for any progressive damage that results from your failure to complete the Recall within a reasonable time after receiving notification.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days. If you are a subsequent stage manufacturer, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to your distributors and retail outlets within five working days. If you have paid to have this recall condition corrected prior to this notice, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement. Please see the reverse side of this notice for details.

Reimbursement to Customers for Repairs Performed Prior to Recall

If you have already **paid** to have this recall condition corrected you may be eligible to receive reimbursement.

Requests for reimbursement may include parts and labor. Reimbursement may be limited to the amount the repair would have cost if completed by an authorized Daimler Trucks North America LLC dealer. The following documentation must be presented to your dealer for consideration for reimbursement.

Please provide original or clear copies of all receipts, invoices, and repair orders that show:

- The name and address of the person who paid for the repair.
- The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) of the vehicle that was repaired.
- What problem occurred, what repair was done, when the repair was done.
- Who repaired the vehicle.
- The total cost of the repair expense that is being claimed.
- Proof of payment for the repair (such as the front and back of a cancelled check or a credit card receipt).

Reimbursement will be made by check from your Daimler Trucks North America LLC dealer.
