REASON FOR THIS COMMUNICATION

To inform you that Ford Motor Company is notifying the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) of an upcoming safety recall on the affected vehicles. Once NHTSA has been informed, there is a possibility that you may be contacted by customers about the recall. This notice will help you answer customer questions.

REASON FOR THIS SAFETY RECALL

In our ongoing discussions with NHTSA, Ford has agreed to expand this action to the geographic areas defined below.

AFFECTED VEHICLES

Certain Ranger and Ford GT vehicles identified below that were originally sold or ever registered in portions of Florida, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Texas, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands, Guam, Saipan, and/or American Samoa.

SERVICE ACTION

It is anticipated that the complete dealer bulletin announcing this upcoming action will be provided to dealers by December 12, 2014. Until that time, continue to process repairs for vehicles identified in OASIS following 14B04 guidelines.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Owners of affected vehicles will not be notified until after dealers have received service repair and parts ordering information.

OASIS AND FSA VIN LISTS

OASIS and FSA VIN lists will be activated once the full dealer bulletin has been posted.
