Our company installs living quarters in both. We have trailer dealers that have our company install LQ in trailers that they have on their floor plan and then they sell to buyers. We also have customers purchase new trailers from dealers and then bring them to us for LQ. We also have customers with existing LQ that bring their trailer to us for remodeling or updating. Our company is certified thru T. R. Arnold and we are inspected quarterly to insure that we are building LQ to RV specifications. We only purchase new equipment for installation (refrigerators from either Dometic Corp. or Norcold). Should we have to work on a unit that is not working properly, we do this according to tech services directions. Please contact me should you need any further information.
