Dear Joe,

Thank you for replacing the above captioned tires. Please hold the tires at your place of business to be picked up by me or someone from my company.

While I have determined that FTS did not import these tires, and that they are technically not part of our recall, I want to take possession of the tires as evidence that other entities were importing tires that are indistinguishable from tires that FTS has imported. **FTS will reimburse Freehold according to our schedule for these tires, but only for these tires. If any other consumers present tires to be recalled, and if FTS determines that it is not the importer, then FTS will decline to pay for the replacement of the tires.**

The tires that you have replaced have the TIN codes 7DT4FTS4005 or 7D4TFTS3905. You have told me that you have purchased the tires from Englewood Tire (201-935-3444). Englewood Tire claims to have purchased the tires from McLenaghan Tire (610-789-5988). At first, Mclenaghan claimed he purchased the tires from TireCo (Compton, Ca), then later claimed the tires were purchased from Reliable Tire (Blackwood, NJ).

While Reliable Tire purchased 100 of these tires which could have date codes later than 3505, the tires were shipped directly to their Dallas location. Reliable confirmed that they have no record of transferring the tires to Blackwood.

Hence, I must conclude that either Reliable purchased the tires from another source (Reliable denies this), or that McLenaghan Tire purchased the tires from another source, possibly TireCo. In either case FTS is not the importer of record.

This is an example of tires that FTS did not import that can not be distinguished from tires that HZR sold to others in The USA.
