

SUBJECT: 114 Winnebago 2003 Journey and Horizon motor homes manufactured between August 23, 2002 and January 2003 and equipped with Caterpillar Model No. 3126E Hydraulically Controlled Electronically Actuated Unit Injected Diesel Engines with High Efficiency Pumps (HEP8). The pump components may experience a high pressure seal failure which can result in a short period of rough running and subsequent engine stall due to a loss of injection actuation pressure. Once engine stall occurs the engine cannot be restarted, which may result in a situation where a vehicle crash could occur.
