SUBJECT: 2,656 Damon 2000-2003 Challenger and Intruder and 2002-2003 Daybreak motor homes manufactured from May 1999 through February 2003, and built on the Ford F53 motorhome chassis. The brake system warning indicator may not function as required by Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 105, "Hydraulic and Electric Brake Systems." The brake system warning indicator may not illuminate when the ignition is in the start position or for a low brake fluid condition.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.


Under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a), it is illegal for anyone, including a manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or retailer to sell an item of equipment or vehicle that fails to comply with all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards.

Effective January 15, 2003, manufacturers are required by 49 CFR 573.6(e)(8)(i) to provide the agency with a plan stating how they will reimburse owners for prenotification remedies.

Please provide us with a draft owner notification letter for our review before mailing to consumers.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin March 30, 2003. Since this is at the end of the quarter, the first quarterly report will be due by July 30, 2003.
