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SUBJECT: 73 Jayco 2002-2003 Firenze motorhomes built on the Ford F53 motorhome chassis manufactured from October 1, 2001 through November 14, 2002. The brake system warning indicator may not function as required by Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 105, "Hydraulic and Electric Brake Systems." The brake system warning indicator may not illuminate when the ignition is in the start position or for a low brake fluid condition. (Jayco Recall Campaign 9901046)

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

Under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a), it is illegal for anyone, including a manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or retailer to sell an item of equipment or vehicle that fails to comply with all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards.

Effective January 15, 2003, manufacturers are required by 49 CFR 573.6(c)(8)(i) to provide the agency with a plan stating how they will reimburse owners for prenotification remedies.

As stated in Part 573.6 submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the cost of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin April 9, 2003. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due July 30, 2003.

We have reviewed your draft owner notification letter and are suggesting a few changes (see attached draft owner notification).
