SUBJECT: 1,842 Rexhall 2000-2003 RoseAir, RexAir, Aerbus, American Clipper, and Vision motorhomes built on the Ford F53 motorhome chassis manufactured from December 7, 2000 through May 4, 2003. The brake system warning indicator may not function as required by Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 105, "Hydraulic and Electric Brake Systems." The brake system warning indicator may not illuminate when the ignition is in the start position or for a low brake fluid condition.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

Under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a), it is illegal for anyone, including a manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or retailer to sell an item of equipment or vehicle that fails to comply with all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards.

Effective January 15, 2003, manufacturers are required by 49 CFR 573.6(c)(8)(i) to provide the agency with a plan stating how they will reimburse owners for prenotification remedies.

Please provide us with a draft owner notification letter for our review before mailing to consumers.

As stated in Part 573.6 submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin July 1, 2003. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due October 30, 2003.
