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SUBJECT: **5,102 Kawasaki 2001 BN125-A4 and 2002 BN125-A5 (and A5L - California version) "Eliminator" motorcycles manufactured from October 2, 2000 through February 7, 2002. The rear brake actuating cam can break where the actuating arm attaches to it, causing a loss of rear brake function.**
