In compliance with your defect investigation request, please accept this letter as confirmation of our receipt, December 31, 2009, of your letter regarding Irvine glass shower doors.

Lakota Corporation previously purchased, from Irvine Shade and Door, the STC17191765GSD glass shower door with towel bar and installed same during 2006 to current.

At this time, Lakota Corporation does not believe a safety defect exists in this equipment. Lakota Corporation has purchased and installed over three-hundred (300) of the STC17191765GSD doors with only one (1) report of breakage of the glass shower door and four (4) reports of breakage of a stationary glass panel of the shower enclosure.

Safety is of paramount importance to Lakota Corporation. If we experience an increase in reports of this defect we will advise you immediately. Should you receive further information to indicate a safety defect does exist with regard to these shower doors, we will of course meet any and all obligations to complete a safety recall.
