You were recently notified by NHTSA that certain shower door products purchased from Irvine Shade & Door, Inc. may have a risk of glass breakage due to towel bars supplied with some of the doors ISD has manufactured. NHSTA recall #'s 07V-411 and 08V-639 detail the nature of the potential problem.

We have determined through an examination of our sales records that Play-mor Trailers did not purchase this type of product or that the shower doors Play-mor Trailers purchased were supplied without towel bars.
