Re: Four Winds International Follow-up on Irvine Corporation.

Dear Mr. Person:

This letter is being written as a follow-up on Four Winds in my letter dated 1/8/2010 regarding Irvine Shade and Door, Inc.

Irvine Shower doors with the towel bars directly mounted to the door; are used in specific floor plan models, manufactured by Four Winds. Since 1/8/2010, Four Winds has been reviewing warranty claim data as it relates to the Irvine Shower Doors. Our review reveals that Four Winds had less than 1/2 of 1% reported incidents of glass breakage during the period between July 2005 and August 2006. Four Winds has not had any more claims reported of this type since August of 2006. We believe that if there was an issue with this component installed in Four Winds vehicles in the field; the time for those to be reported has run its course and is reflected in the data.

In considering a field action on this component, we are concerned that we may create new problems by the disassembly and reassembly of components that have been problem free to this point.

We will continue to monitor this issue closely and act appropriately if we see any change in our warranty claims data on these components.
