Safety Recall Notice **Airstream Classic Trailers** **NHTSA Recall Number 10V-xxx**

Dear Customer:

This **Safety Recall Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and is important for your safety.

Reason for This Recall

Airstream decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety may exist in certain Airstream Classic Travel Trailers manufactured between March 2005 and April 2009. It has been determined that these vehicles were manufactured with a hydraulic brake controller manufactured by Active Technologies that could fail under certain circumstances. It is possible that the brake controller can fail unexpectedly causing the brakes on the trailer to lock up or to fail completely. The locking of the brakes or brake failure could result in a loss of vehicle control that could result in a crash that could cause damage to the trailer and tow vehicle and possible serious injury or death to you.

What We Will Do

Airstream will inspect the brake controller and if found to be defective it will be replaced. The inspection and brake controller replacement, if required, will be done at no cost to you.

What You Should Do

Please contact your nearest Airstream dealer and arrange an appointment to have your trailer inspected. It is estimated that inspection and repairs, if required, could take up to 3 hours. If you any questions regarding this recall, or need assistance in locating an Airstream certified dealer please contact the **Airstream Warranty/Service Department** by phone at 937-596-6111.

Notifications

We have notified the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of this recall and the procedures involved. Should Airstream fail or be unable to correct the defect without charge, you may write to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE., Washington, DC 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to lessee within 10 days.
