Mr. Yon,

Chrysler Group LLC is currently in the process of gathering the information to support NHTSA's PE10-031 affecting Jeep Grand Cherokees built from MY 1993 to MY 2004. Based on a review of the content and scope of the Information Request, it is not likely that Chrysler can provide a comprehensive response by the current due date of October 15, 2010. Given the number of body styles and model years involved, Chrysler is proposing an extension of 4 weeks (November 15, 2010) for questions #'s 5, 6, 8 and 10. Chrysler would provide its response to the remainder of the questions on October 12, 2010.

We would appreciate your consideration of this request and your notification to us as soon as possible regarding the Agency's decision.
