



Safety Recall Notice

NHTSA Recall No. 11V-486

Dear Open Range R.V. Dealer:

Open Range R.V. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in Open Range/Journeyer, 2010-2011 Travel Trailer model # JT340FLR model bearing production dates starting 8/27/2009 through 11/17/2010 are affected.

Open Range R.V. has determined that a number of these units may lack a main supporting cross member(s) in the frame. This condition presents an accident, and/or rollover risk.

Open Range R.V., is conducting a safety recall campaign to inspect and, where necessary correct this issue. Accordingly Open Range R.V. will contact you soon to provide you with a VIN list of potentially affected vehicles that have been delivered to your dealer location, along with inspection/remedy instructions for units in your inventory and units that are brought in by vehicle owners.

In the meantime, please ensure that the model JT340FLR's on your lot are not used until they have been inspected and, as necessary, repaired.

It is a violation of Federal law to deliver the recalled equipment and/or vehicles containing this equipment, under sale or lease until this defect has been remedied. Accordingly, no unit should be delivered to customers until it has been inspected and, where necessary, corrected.
