SUBJECT: 1,085 Fleetwood 2002-2004 Revolution motor homes manufactured from August 1, 2001 through August 15, 2003. The electric power for the entry doorstep "Last Out" feature has not been provided and the entry doorstep will not operate in "Last Out" mode. The "Last Out" is a safety feature that causes the entry doorstep to extend one last time if the entry doorstep power switch is off and the vehicle ignition is turned off.
Fleetwood Recall No. 30815.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

We have reviewed your draft owner notification letter and have a few suggested changes. A risk statement needs to be added under "What is the Problem" paragraph, i.e., Owners may fall or slip if the entry doorstep has not operated properly.

A sentence needs to be added to the owner letter concerning leased vehicles, i.e., "Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days."

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during September 2003. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by October 30, 2003.
