**SUBJECT:** Undetermined quantity of Coachmen motor homes equipped with Samsung microwave ovens installed in recreational vehicles for microwave cooking. These units were produced with a defect membrane panel. An electrical short can occur between circuit patterns on the membrane panel, especially overlapped by a "Jumper" or jump wire. This may cause the oven to activate without pressing any key pads.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgement letter will be written ONLY if we have additional comments or concerns.

It is our understanding that Samsung (03E-044) will conduct the owner notification and remedy for this recall. As stated in your Part 573 report, Coachmen will provide us with the quantity, models, and beginning and ending production dates of these motor homes.
