About 500 kits were installed by September 30, 2003.

(b) Total Number Inspected & NOT REQUIRING REMEDY: 280 units have been determined to NOT require remedial or repair work. These items are either replacements for installation in the population listed in line 4(a) or are installed in marine vessels and subject to different operating conditions than motor vehicles.
