
SUBJECT: 3,641 Keystone 2002-2003 Outback trailers manufactured from August 2001 through February 2003; 2001 Sprinter and Springdale trailers manufactured from September through October 2000; and 2003 Challenger and Everest trailers manufactured from October through November 2002. These vehicles are equipped with Samsung microwave ovens. These units were produced with a defect membrane panel. An electrical short can occur between circuit patterns on the membrane panel, especially overlapped by a "Jumper" or jump wire. This may cause the oven to activate without pressing any keypads.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgement letter will be written ONLY if we have additional comments or concerns.

It is our understanding that Samsung (03E-044) will conduct the owner notification and remedy for this recall.
