SUBJECT: 848 GM 1997 Saturn EV1 electric vehicles manufactured from August 1996 through June 1997, and 1997-1998 Chevrolet S-10 electric light duty pickup trucks manufactured from April 1997 through March 1998. These vehicles were built with a charge port assembly that could fall during a charging event. Heat could build up within the charge port and a fire could result. GM Recall No. 00025.

This is an initial acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be forthcoming shortly. After our review of your report and associated documents, we may have additional comments or concerns.

In accordance with Part 577, amended July 7, 1995, a draft owner notification letter must be submitted for review prior to mailing as well as an estimated owner notification date.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. The current quarter began January 1 and ends on March 31, 2000. If owner notification occurs during this period, the first quarterly report will be due by April 30, 2000.

We have reviewed General Motors Corporation's (GM) Defect Information Report dated March 3, 2000, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573, "Defect and Noncompliance Reports." This recall involves 848 GM 1997 Saturn EV1 electric vehicles manufactured from August 1996 through June 1997, and 1997-1998 Chevrolet S-10 electric light duty pickup trucks manufactured from April 1997 through March 1998. 
GM is responsible for the remedy of these vehicles from this date forward, regardless of vehicle age, mileage, or ownership.
