Hyundai Motor America submits this letter for purposes of compliance with the quarterly reporting requirements of 49 C.F.R. Section 573.6. The following information is submitted for the calendar quarter ending December 31, 2003. This recall involves the Hyundai Elantra and Tiburon, which are manufactured by Hyundai Motor Company.

The following information is identified by and in the order of the paragraph headings of Section 573.6(b):
