SUBJECT: 765 Fleetwood 2004 Prowler, Wilderness, Terry, Mallard, Pioneer and Gearbox conventional and fifth wheel travel trailers equipped with Siemens Q circuit breaker and manufactured from July 18, 2003 through September 10, 2003. The circuit breakers were mis-marked. (*Fleetwood Recall No. 40322*)

We have reviewed your proposed owner notification letter and have the following suggested changes:

- In the first paragraph, please correct "National Traffic Safety and Motor Vehicle Safety Act" to read "National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act."
- On the second page under "What should you do?", 6th paragraph, please change the word "tool-free" to "toll-free."
- Add a sentence reading, "Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days."

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin by April 5, 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by July 30, 2004.
