RE: Recall 02VZ78000 -- Bosch Brake -- Delay of Owner Notification

Dear Mr. Person:

Pursuant to 573.50 (8) (ii) Monaco Coach Corporation is notifying NHTSA that the beginning date reported to the agency for notifying owners involved in this recall will be delayed by more than 2 calendar weeks. Our initial date of notification was filed as July 15, 2004 but will be delayed until August 18, 2004. This delay is due to the concern with the availability of parts that will be supplied by Bosch. We feel that it is of great importance that we have these parts on site with Monaco National Parts prior to releasing the owner notification. We believe by scheduling the release mid -August we and our dealers will be better prepared to serve our Customers in timely matter.

Monaco's time line for the release of this recall is as follows:

Dealer notification -- by certified Mail -- First week of August

Outside Mail Service will prepare Owner Notification (will take 3-5 working days) - Second Week of August

Owner Notification --Will be mailed August 18, 2004

The Company has filed the Dealer and Owner Letters and the Reimbursement Program for this recall with NHTSA for approval.
