SUBJECT: 1,205 Carriage 2002-2004 Cameo, 2004 Compass travel and fifth wheel trailers, and 2003 Carri-Lite fifth wheel trailers equipped with Samsung microwaves. The microwaves were produced with a defective panel. An electrical short can occur between circuit patterns on the membrane panel, especially overlapped by a "jumper" or jump wire. This may cause the oven to activate without pressing any key pads.

This is an initial acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be forthcoming shortly. After our review of your report and associated documents, we may have additional comments or concerns.

As stated in your report, Samsung will conduct the owner notification and remedy for this campaign.
