SUBJECT: 84 Haulmark 1996-2001 trailers manufactured from November 1996 through September 2000. The generator exhaust opening is under the trailer instead of being vented out the side of the trailer. Trailer occupants could experience carbon monoxide poisoning which could result in illness or death.

This is an **initial** acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be forthcoming shortly. After our review of your report and associated documents, we may have additional comments or concerns.

We have reviewed your draft owner/dealer notification letters and they meet the requirements of Part 577.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during October/November 2000. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due in this office by January 30, 2001.
