SUBJECT: ³⁴ Damon 2001 Challenger motor homes, Models 310 and 335, manufactured from July 10 through October 27, 2000. The furnace is exposed to a storage compartment. Items stored in the compartment under the range could come in contact with the furnace, potentially becoming heated and result in a fire. *Damon Safety Recall No. 00-086.*

This is an initial acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be forthcoming shortly. After our review of your report and associated documents, we may have additional comments or concerns.

In accordance with Part 577, amended July 7, 1995, a draft owner notification letter must be submitted for review prior to mailing.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin December 11, 2000. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by January 30, 2001.
