Dear Mr. Hagie:

Kawasaki Motors Corporation, USA. (Kawasaki) is requested, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 30165, 30166, and 30119, to renotify owners involved in safety recall 03V-140 who have not had their vehicles corrected or otherwise accounted for. This recall involves 5,127 MY 2001 Kawasaki BN125-A4 and 2002 Kawasaki BN125-A5 motorcycles which the rear brake actuating cam can break. The remedy for this recall campaign was to have the dealer replace the brake cam. Owner notification began on April 24, 2003. Through the second quarter of 2004, Kawasaki's fifth reporting quarter, Kawasaki reports that of the 5,127 vehicles involved, 2336 have been remedied, resulting in a completion rate of 47 percent.

Kawasaki should conduct the owner renotification in accordance with the guidelines listed below.

- Before conducting the owner renotification, Kawasaki should obtain an updated owner list, for this recall campaign, based on current state motor vehicle registration records.
- Kawasaki's proposed owner renotification letter for this recall must meet the requirements of 49 CFR Part 577.10, "Follow-up Notification," and must be submitted to NHTSA for review before owner renotification begins. Part 577.10(e)(1) specifically requires that the renotification letter be identified as a "follow-up to an earlier communication."
- In addition to the six quarterly status reports required under 49 CFR Part 573.6, "Quarterly Reports," Kawasaki is requested to file three additional quarterly status reports.





- Furnish a proposed schedule for conducting the owner renotification that includes the following information:
 - a. the date on which the search of current state motor vehicle registration records will be initiated in order to update the original owner list;
 - b. the approximate date on which the revised owner list will be available to initiate owner renotification;
 - c. the approximate date on which the owner renotification will begin; and
 - d. the approximate date on which the owner renotification will be completed (if the owner renotification is to be staggered, give the beginning and ending owner renotification date for each segment).

Kawasaki's renotification schedule and a draft of the proposed owner renotification letter must be submitted to this office by November 10, 2004.
