# SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Affinia Group has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain brake hydraulic master cylinders manufactured by its subsidiary, Brake Parts Incorporated. These products were marketed by **[Brand Name Owner]** under the **[Brand Name]** brand name. Affinia is recalling the affected product.

## WHAT PRODUCTS ARE INVOLVED?

This recall involves brake hydraulic master cylinders with the part numbers identified in the table below, and which were manufactured from July 27, 2005 through January 17, 2006. These products were sold exclusively in the aftermarket for use on the vehicles identified.

***Important Note: Only products with date codes 0529 through 0602 on the packaging are subject to this recall.***

## WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

When subjected to very cold temperatures, i.e., below 5 degrees Fahrenheit (-15 Celsius), an internal seal in the master cylinder may lose flexibility. This condition may cause brake fluid to leak, leading to a decrease in brake line pressure and an increase in stopping distance. The driver may feel a distending, or spongy brake pedal, and/or notice a warning brake lamp light on the vehicle instrument panel. This condition could lead to a vehicle crash.
