Re: Travel Trailer, Fifth Wheel Trailer and Truck Camper, Recall 06E-076

Skyline Corporation has been notified by Dometic Corporation of a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety in the refrigerators installed in certain travel trailers, fifth wheel trailers and truck campers manufactured at its subsidiaries facilities in Elkhart, Indiana; Leola, Pennsylvania; Hemet, California; McMinnville, Oregon and Mansfield, Texas, as described below.

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573.5(c), Skyline hereby submits the following information:

1. Name of Manufacturer: Skyline Homes, Inc., Homette Corporation, and Layton Homes Corp., all of which are wholly-owned subsidiaries of Skyline Corporation.
2. Identification of Vehicles: 1997-2004 Aljo, Celebrity, Century, Layton, Nomad, Seaview and Weekender brand travel trailers, fifth wheel trailers and truck campers manufactured between April 1997 and August 2003.
3. Number of Vehicles: 57,295
4. Percentage of Vehicles with Defect: Based on information received from Dometic, Skyline believes that approximately .06 percent of these vehicles actually contain the defect.
5. Description of Defect: Under some circumstances, a fatigue crack can develop in the boiler tube of the subject refrigerators, which can permit the release of pressurized coolant solution. If this solution is exposed to an ignition source under certain specific circumstances, it can result in a vehicle fire.
6. Basis for Recall: Leaking coolant is a fire hazard. Skyline is not aware of any fires in its vehicles that are related to this defect.

7. Recall Program: Dometic has arranged to conduct a recall to remedy the potential defect in Skyline recreational vehicles at no charge to vehicle owners. Pursuant to 49 CFR 573.6(c)(8)(i) and 573.13, owners will be advised that Dometic will reimburse them if they have incurred costs to obtain a remedy for a refrigerator containing such a defect prior to their receipt of the notification

8. Recall Notice: Dometic has engaged Stericycle expertRECALL to notify retail customers and dealers and to provide NHTSA with quarterly reports. Skyline has not been provided with a copy of the owner and dealer notifications. Stericycle has been given a spreadsheet of all Skyline vehicle identification numbers and owner information.
