This will amend our Part 573 Report dated February 15, 2007, by providing the following additional information regarding Voluntary Recall 07V-063.

In addition to the vehicles already specified under Voluntary Recall 07V-063, Volkswagen will also include model year 2003-2005 Passat and Passat wagons equipped with a brake light switch (part number 3B0 945 511 _) to this campaign within the VIN ranges of:

2003-2005 Passat and Passat Wagon (5th Generation):



The number of affected vehicles is approximately 212,000. Dealer notification is scheduled on or before May 21, 2007. Pending sufficient parts availability of the new switch, customers affected by this update will be notified using a staggered approach beginning on or before August 24, 2007, ending on or before September 21, 2007. Dealers will install a newly-designed brake light switch at no cost to consumers.

Until the date of customer notification, any subject vehicle that is presented for service to an authorized Volkswagen dealer with a malfunctioning brake light switch will be repaired free of charge.
