Summary:

ON CERTAIN CLASS C MOTOR HOMES, THE SPARE WHEEL, WHEN INSTALLED ON THE FRONT AXLE, MAY CONTACT THE FRONT BRAKE CALIPER MOUNTING BRACKETS AND THE DRIVER MAY EXPERIENCE A GRINDING/SCRAPING NOISE IN THE FRONT WITH THE SPARE WHEEL INSTALLED.

Consequence:

THIS COULD CAUSE PREMATURE WHEEL FAILURE RESULTING IN A LOSS OF VEHICLE CONTROL OR A CRASH COULD OCCUR.

Remedy:

DEALERS WILL INSPECT AND INSTALL THE CORRECT SPARE WHEEL. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN ON OR ABOUT JULY 30, 2007. OWNERS MAY CONTACT FLEETWOOD AT 800-322-8216.

Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on or before 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
