# IMPORTANT NOTICE TO U.S. DEALERS - FOR IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION SAFETY RECALL N4 Information Regarding Customer Notification Letters

Some of our customers may have wrongly received a Safety Recall N4 letter stating that their vehicle was already updated with a new brake light switch. In the majority of cases, these letters were sent to the correct customer, but in a minority of cases this letter was sent mistakenly due to an error in the mailing process.

In the interest of ensuring that all customers receive the correct information, we are sending all customers potentially affected by this mailing error the correct letter for their vehicle.

To help ensure customer satisfaction, and to help eliminate any potential confusion, we're asking for your help. Here's what you can do:

- When you are contacted by a customer regarding the N4 (or any other campaign), please check the VIN in ElsaWeb to confirm that the campaign is open on the vehicle **prior** to scheduling a repair appointment.
- If the campaign shows open in ElsaWeb, please schedule the repair for the customer, regardless of which letter the customer is referencing.
- If the campaign does not show open in ElsaWeb, check the campaign history to see if the campaign has already been completed.
- If you have any questions about whether a campaign is applicable to a vehicle or not, please contact the Campaign Helpline at 1-800-741-2919.
