This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2007 and 2008 Montana Fifth Wheels. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

***Reason  
for this  
recall***

The vehicles subject to this recall campaign may have excess paint at the wheel and the hub face mounting surface. The excess paint may cause the lug nuts to loose torque over time and could ultimately cause wheel separation if the torque is not maintained. Wheel separation could result in poor vehicle handling and increased risk of property damage and a vehicle crash.

***What we  
will do***

Keystone representatives have been in contact with the staff at your selling dealership regarding this situation. The remedy is to remove the wheels, remove the paint from the hub face wheel mounting surface and then reinstall and torque the wheels to the proper specification. The service and parts required for this corrective action will be provided at no charge to you.

***What we  
need you  
to do***

At your earliest convenience, please make an appointment to have your RV serviced by your dealership. The labor time to perform this correction is approximately 3 hours. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your RV for this repair.

***If you have

Your dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your RV is corrected as promptly as possible. If your dealer is unable to assist or if you take your RV to your dealer on the agreed service date, and the dealer does not remedy the condition within a reasonable amount of time, or without charge to you, please contact Keystone Customer Service by calling 1-866-425-4369.
