Subject: Safety Recall 07KWA – Removable Front Tow Hitch

Dear Kenworth Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some Kenworth T2000, T600/T660, and T800 models manufactured August 2, 2004 through May 16, 2007 with a removable front tow hitch(es). Your vehicle has been identified as possibly having been manufactured with this defect.

The removable tow hitch (part number A20-1009) can fail when used to tow or lift a vehicle. Using the removable tow hitch may cause an accident that could result in personal injury or death. This condition was determined to be a safety-related defect.

<i>The problem is...</i>	The removable tow hitch may fail when used to tow or lift the vehicle.
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	The dealer will replace the defective tow hitch.
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Do not use the removable tow hitch. Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment to have the defective part replaced at no cost to you.
	Or
	Bring your defective part to the dealer and exchange it for a new part.

Kenworth has initiated a recall to replace the removable tow hitch(es). Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. To find your nearest Kenworth dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Kenworth.com. This procedure should take no more than 10 minutes and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

If you require further information about this recall, reimbursement of a pre-notification remedy associated with this recall or experience any difficulty in making arrangements for this repair, please contact: Kenworth Truck Company, P.O. Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you no longer own this vehicle, we would appreciate your advising us of the new owner if you know their name. The enclosed card may be used for this purpose.
