Dear Mr. Person,

In response to NHTSA's EQ08-010, Blue Bird Body Company in conjunction with Complete Coachworks of Riverside, Ca. has conducted a review of the body files for each Wanderlodge motor home manufactured and delivered from June 01, 2003 through September 01, 2006 to determine the make and model of refrigerators installed in each motor home. Our review found two Dometic refrigerators were installed. However; the models installed were not the models identified in Dometic's Notification of Defect to NHTSA dated April 11, 2008.

A review of our school bus division records was also conducted and the suspect Dometic models were not found to be installed on any vehicle produced by the school bus division (such as multi purpose vehicles or export units).

Since Blue Bird does not have a record of the suspect Dometic models being installed in any of its products, a defect notification is not required.
