



**EMISSIONS RECALL L34 – REPROGRAM PCM
DOWNSTREAM OXYGEN SENSOR SLOW RESPONSE MONITOR**

Dear: (Name)

Chrysler has determined that the **2010 and early 2011 model year Jeep® Wrangler vehicles equipped with a 3.8L engine** may require reprogramming of the Powertrain Control Module (PCM).

The problem is... The PCM on your Jeep (VIN: xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx) may have been inadvertently programmed with software that may not run the Downstream Oxygen Sensor Slow Response Monitor as frequently as required by regulations. This can allow an improperly operating Oxygen Sensor to go undetected and result in excessive exhaust emissions which may exceed EPA and California Emissions Standards.

What your dealer will do... Chrysler will repair your vehicle free of charge (parts and labor). To do this, your dealer will reprogram your vehicle's PCM. The work will take about ½ hour to complete. However, additional time may be necessary depending on service schedules.

What you must do... Simply contact your dealer right away to schedule a service appointment.

California residents... The State of California requires the completion of emission recall repairs prior to vehicle registration renewal. Your dealer will provide you with a Vehicle Emission Recall Proof of Correction Form after the recall service is performed. Be sure to save this form since the California Department of Motor Vehicles may require that you supply it as proof that the recall has been performed.

Please help us update our records by filling out the attached prepaid postcard, if any of the conditions listed on the card apply to you or your vehicle. You may also update this information on the web at

If you have already experienced this condition and have paid to have it repaired, you may send your original receipts and/or other adequate proof of payment to the following address for reimbursement: Chrysler Recall Customer Assistance, P.O. In order to ensure your full protection under the emission warranty provisions, it is recommended that you have your vehicle serviced as soon as possible. Failure to do so could legally be determined to be a lack of proper maintenance of your vehicle. Further, without this repair, your vehicle may fail a state or local emission inspection test.
