Hyundai Motor Company previously submitted a Defect Information Report to NHTSA regarding a recall campaign of certain model year 2012 through 2013 Hyundai Sonata vehicles produced beginning on January 24, 2012 through June 21, 2012 (NHTSA Recall Number 12V-352) pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

On July 24, 2012, Hyundai reported the affected quantities to be 22,512 model year 2012 and 2013 Hyundai Sonata vehicles. Hyundai was subsequently notified by its supplier that it had performed a confirmatory review of their data and is revising the number of affected inflator modules. The revisions affect the recall campaign parameters as follows:

1. The affected vehicle production range has been revised to January 24, 2012 through July 20, 2012.
2. The number of affected vehicles has been increased by 7,255 units. Approximately 29,707 model year 2012 and 2013 Hyundai Sonata vehicles are affected in the United States. Approximately 60 vehicles are affected in Puerto Rico.
