IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear SAILUN S825 Tire Owner :

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

TBC has been notified by Sailun Co., that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain **Sailun S825 385/65R22.5 18PR 158K tires.**

! I M P O R T A N T !

- A Specific range of Sailun S825 385/65R22.5 18PR 158K tires are being recalled.
- You should contact the Sailun Tire Dealer from which you purchased the above item to determine if your tire may be defective.

Why is a recall being conducted?

Your tire may have a defect involving the possibility of inadequate liner gauge which could lead to reduced air retention over a period of time leading to the formation of separation and eventual tire failure increasing the risk of a crash .

A total of 44 tires with date codes of (1312 & 1412) are involved in this recall.		

What should you do?

If you own a Sailun S825 385/65R22.5 18PR 158K tire(s) containing either of the above DOT numbers please visit your place of purchase at your earliest convenience and they will replace and mount the tires at no charge.

Please bring this letter with you to the dealer, as it identifies that you may be eligible to obtain tire replacement service.


If you have paid to have this recall condition corrected prior to this notice you may be eligible to receive reimbursement. If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations

This campaign will expire 60 days from the date of this letter, so it is important that you act as soon as possible to determine whether your tires are covered by this campaign. If you have any problems obtaining the needed replacement, please contact TBC Corporation Quality Assurance Department at (800) 739-7698.
