RE: NHTSA Recall 12V-568, Hyundai Recall 108 - Revised affected production range

Dear Ms. Lewis:

On behalf of Hyundai Motor Company (Hyundai), Hyundai-Kia America Technical Center, Inc. (HATCI), previously submitted a Defect Information Report to NHTSA on December 06, 2012 regarding a recall campaign of model year 2012 Hyundai Veloster vehicles equipped with panoramic sunroofs produced beginning on November 01, 2011 through April 17, 2012 pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Based on discussions with and additional information received from NHTSA, Hyundai will revise the affected production range of affected vehicles to include those produced beginning on July 04, 2011 through October 31, 2011. Hyundai has added 5,835 2012 Hyundai Veloster vehicles equipped with panoramic sunroofs in the US, and 236 units in Puerto Rico, bringing the total affected population to approximately 19,600.

Dealers will be notified regarding this revised affected production range the week of February 18, 2013. The existing Technical Service Bulletin providing the service procedure will be updated to reflect the revised affected production range. Notification letters to owners of affected vehicles produced from July 04, 2011 through October 31, 2011 will be mailed in March, 2013.
