This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Lion Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in your 2014 Lion bus. The air compressor discharge line may chafe against the hydraulic brake line resulting in a hole in the brake line. This could result in a loss of brake fluid and occur without warning. A loss of brake fluid could result in increased stopping distance of the school bus. Increased stopping distance could result in a vehicle crash.

WHAT WE WILL DO

The repair will be done under warranty and at no charge to you.

VEHICLE INVOLVE IN THIS RECALL

Vehicle serial number 4VZJP2A90EC076525

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

The vehicle in your fleet must be checked immediately to find out if there is any friction between the 2 lines ; if so, use a piece of rubber hose to separate the 2 lines and try to bend a bit to add distance between them up to the time of repair. You are advised immediately to schedule the repair with your service department or the local service center.

If the brake line is damaged or rub on the air compressor line, please contact immediately Marc-André Pagé at 1-800-546-6706 ext. 231 to get the necessary parts to correct the problem at no charge
