SUBJECT: Incorrect Gauges and ABS Light

Attention Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Temsa Global (TEMSA) has decided that certain model year 2011-2013 TS35C and 2012-2013 TS30 motorcoaches fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 121 "Air Brake Systems." First, the two service air brake pressure gauges are both reading the pressure of the same air tank. Second, the ABS system check lamp that should light up when the ignition is turned "ON" or "RUN" may fail to indicate an ABS malfunction if there is an engine failure or if there are numerous other failure indications already existing on the cluster. Without accurate gauges, the driver may not notice the pressure change in the secondary brake system. The driver may also not be aware of an ABS issue without the bulb illuminating each time the key is turned to on position or when the key is in run position. Either issue increases the risk of a crash. Please see the enclosed TEMSA Service Bulletin TS-S35 for further information and remedy action.

Temsa is conducting a recall to remedy the ABS light and incorrect gauge. The recall work will be provided at no cost to you. Temsa records indicate that you are the owner or operator of the following vehicle(s) included in this recall:

Temsa strongly urges you to have the recall work performed on your vehicle(s) as quickly as possible. You may contact TEMSA at 1-404-602-0151 if you have any questions about this recall campaign. Approximate repair time for each effected vehicle is twenty minutes (0,33 hrs).

If you have sold or otherwise transferred the vehicle(s) identified above, please contact Temsa at 1-404-602-0151 with all of the information you have regarding the current owner/operator of the vehicle(s). Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Federal law requires any lessor who receives a notification of a determination of a safety related defect or noncompliance pertaining to any leased motor vehicle shall send the notice to the lessee within 10 days.
