As a follow-up to the initial Defect and Noncompliance Information Report filed with your office on June 24, 2013, the following information is being provided by EverGreen Recreational Vehicles, LLC ("EverGreen") in order to complete the information requirements in connection with the above-referenced recall campaign.

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. EverGreen has determined that there are actually 183 Element and Ever-Lite travel trailers that are subject to this recall campaign. These 183 affected travel trailers were manufactured by EverGreen during the period beginning in July 2009 and ending in July 2011.
- B. Owner Notifications. The owner notification letter that EverGreen plans to send to the registered owners of the travel trailers that are subject to this recall campaign is enclosed for your review and approval. The envelope to be used by EverGreen to mail the owner notification letter to the registered owners of the affected travel trailers is also enclosed for your review and approval.
- C. Dealer Notifications. The Important Safety Recall Campaign Notice and the Process Instruction that EverGreen plans to send to its dealers in connection with this recall campaign are also enclosed for your review.
